Our Lions & Leos at Project Cure

PROJECT C.U.R.E. is one of the largest nonprofit organizations in the world that delivers medical supplies and equipment

to developing countries. Its main purpose is to collect and sort donated medical supplies and equipment

from manufacturers, hospitals, and surpluses and then distribute the supplies and equipment



to developing countries based on a needs assessment of the local hospitals and clinics in those countries. Our Club provides assistance with inventorying and sorting donated supplies.








Our Club donates several hours on Dec. 24th, preparing Christmas gifts for the children and the families in the hospital.




Our club donates an afternoon twice a year in RONALD HOUSES preparing meals and general housekeeping chores for the families with children in the hospital.





A *Ronald McDonald* House provides a place for families to call home so they can stay close by their hospitalized child at little to no cost. No eligible family is ever turned away or denied future access to the program because they could not make a donation.



This 501c3 charitable organization was formed out of the necessity to fund Cataract Surgeries and Humanitarian Needs to the poorest people, primarily in the Philippines. In recent years, we have responded to Mexican requests to perform Cataract Surgeries also. This service was pioneered by Dr. Rey Vito in the mid 90's, followed by Dr Doro Federis. Thereafter, the torch is being spearheaded by Dr Conrad Ballecer Jr.
