## Our Lions & Leos at Project Cure

**PROJECT C.U.R.E.** is one of the largest nonprofit organizations in the world that delivers medical supplies and equipment to developing countries. Its main purpose is to collect and sort donated medical supplies and equipment



from manufacturers, hospitals, and surpluses and then distribute the supplies and equipment

to developing countries based on a needs assessment of the local hospitals and clinics in those countries. Our Club provides assistance with inventorying and sorting donated supplies.



## *Simbang Gabi*

is a Filipino Christmas tradition. It is a series of nine dawn masses on the days leading up to Christmas. It begins on December 16 and ends at midnight on the 24th of December, when a midnight mass is held.

volunteers several hours each quarter to pack the dry ingredients, vegetables, proteins and vitamins into nutritious food packets to be sent to Third World Countries.

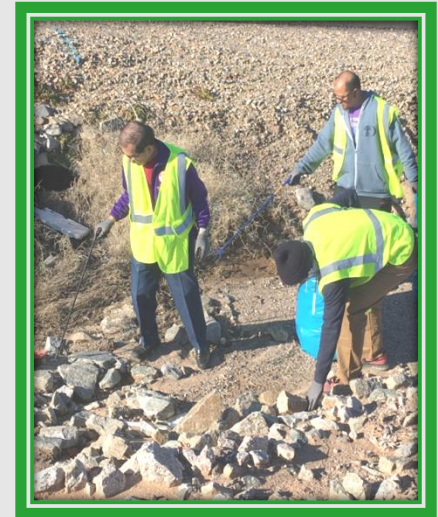
Feed My Starving Children believes hope starts with food. As a Christian nonprofit, FMSC is dedicated to seeing every child whole in body and spirit.

This 501c3 charitable organization was formed out of the necessity to fund Cataract Surgeries and Humanitarian Needs to the poorest people, primarily in the Philippines. In recent years, we have responded to Mexican requests to perform Cataract Surgeries also. This service was pioneered by Dr. Rey Vito in the mid 90's, followed by Dr Doro Federis. Thereafter, the torch is being spearheaded by Dr Conrad Ballecer Jr.
